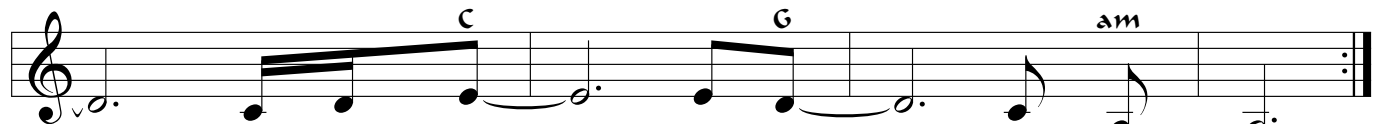


THE STONE
